



## **Dimensions Trampoline Club**

### **Video/Photography Policy**

Updated March 2022

Due to change of venue, and, our new diary of sessions, we have reviewed the Dimensions policy of Video and Photography in accordance with British Gymnastics' Policies & Procedures <https://www.british-gymnastics.org/docman/footer-menu-items/governance-documents/11240-photography-policy-v1-0-march-2020/file>. This is to help protect the privacy of all gymnasts and coaches within the club.

**We do not always have sole use of the viewing gallery/hall during our sessions and cannot always observe who is videoing/photographing your children. For the protection of your children and our staff/volunteers, please read and adhere to the following.**

#### **Gymnasts:**

We appreciate that some of you need to bring your mobile phones with you so you can contact parents/guardians if needed. However:

1. Mobile phones should be left with your belongings during the session; in a bag or pocket, not loose on the floor. Dimensions cannot take responsibility for loss or damage to mobiles phones during the sessions.
2. During “Club” Sessions, no videoing/photography of your moves with personal devices will be allowed. The club has an iPad on which moves can be recorded during the session. This is of great value to the gymnast to see and analyse their performance, but these are deleted regularly.
3. If you particularly wish to record a move to show family/friends this can be done at the end of your session during “Do What You Like” with the supervision and permission of the coach. If your videos or photos have other club members/Coaches in them, please do **NOT** post them on any social media

sites. If you consider carefully where the person filming stands and the position of the spotters/coaches, it should be possible to only have yourself in the image/video.

4. **Competition Squad** members are allowed to use their own personal devices to video their routines/moves by either their training buddy or coach, **BUT** this must be on their own device and you **MUST** have permission from your coach. This is for personal training use only. It is highly unlikely that your video/Photo will not have a coach or other Squad members in it, so it is **NOT** allowed to be posted anywhere on any social media sites and should be deleted after use.

### **Parents/Guardians**

We understand that your child will be performing some fantastic moves during their sessions; however, we request that you follow these guidelines to assist us in protecting the privacy and safety of other gymnasts and coaches.

Therefore:

Please DO NOT take photos or videos from up in the Gallery. Should you wish to video/photograph your child performing a move, you are welcome to come down to the hall 10 minutes before your child's session finishes, where we would be happy to arrange for your child to perform the move/routine so it can be recorded/photographed with the permission and supervision of their coach.

**Competition Squad** members can request their routines to be filmed by a responsible adult in the gallery for training purposes only, in preparation for a competition. You should always ensure you have permission of the Coach first. This is so the Coaches can be aware of who will be videoing and when.

**This new guideline is for the protection of all children and coaches within the club.**
